### 3. OVERVIEW

---



A Quick Start Guide is integrated into the product. It is an excellent introduction and you are strongly advised to consult it first, giving you an overview to allow an even faster startup.

#### 3.1 Create your account

- Connect to the Internet and go to the site:  
<http://www.clairefontaine-paperpc.com>
- Click on "Create an account",
- Complete the required fields, including "E-mail address",
- The connection password is sent to the e-mail address given.

#### 3.2 Install the digital pen drivers

Before continuing, you should ensure that the drivers of the digital pen are installed on your personal computer.

To do this, refer to the documentation provided by the manufacturer of your digital pen.

#### 3.3 Reference your digital pen

- Connect to the Internet and go to the site:  
<http://www.clairefontaine-paperpc.com>
- Click on "User Access",
- Complete the "Login" and "Password" fields with the settings given when creating your account,
- Click on the "Personal settings" tab,
- Click on "Pens", then on "Add",
- Complete the following fields:
  - "Type": select the model of your digital pen in the drop-down menu,
  - "Label": the name of the digital pen (free text entry),
  - "Identification number": unique number identifying the digital pen, it takes the form XXX-XXX-XXX-XX. If this number is not given on the body of your digital pen, see § 11.6,
- Validate using the "Validate" button.



### 3.4 Activate your PaperPC

- Point to the “Start New PaperPC” box on the inside front cover of your PaperPC, see § 11.8.1:




- This operation only needs to be carried out once, but must be repeated before starting any PaperPC of any type.

### 3.5 Write/draw

Write or draw naturally in your PaperPC with your digital pen, in the same way as you would with a traditional “analog” pen.

### 3.6 Save your contents

Point to the “SEND TO PC” box, , then connect your digital pen to the USB port of your personal computer.

### 3.7 View your saved contents

- Connect to the Internet and go to the site:  
<http://www.clairefontaine-paperpc.com>
- Complete the “Login” and “Password” fields with the settings given when creating your account,
- Click on the “Data management” tab,
- Select and then open the PaperPC that you have just started,
- Open your saved notes.

### 3.8 Download MyNotes Desktop

- Connect to the Internet and go to the site:  
<http://www.clairefontaine-paperpc.com>
- Complete the “Login” and “Password” fields with the settings given when creating your account,
- Click on the “Support” tab, then on “Download”,
- Finally, click on the link corresponding to the version of MyNotes Desktop optimized for your operating system.

For the automatic update version, installation is also automatic. If the JVM (Java Virtual Machine) is not installed on your personal computer, it will start downloading automatically.



MyNotes Desktop is a powerful tool for managing your personal data. To find out more about it, see chapter 7.
